

Development of Romanian Regions

Objective of REGIO (ROP)-Regional Operational Programme:

to reduce the gaps between the regions

- Romania allocation for 2007-2013: 4,84 bil. euro
- Romania allocation for 2014-2020: 8,25 bil. euro







Priority axis 9: Supporting the economic and social regeneration of the disadvantaged communities from the urban area

Financial allocation : 11,8 mil Euro

- Investments in social housing infrastructure
- Investments for health and social services infrastructure
- Investments for educational infrastructure

Potential beneficiaries: Local Action Groups: representatives of the local public authorities, institutions, local business environment, civil society, marginalized urban area selected for the investment



Priority axis 10: Improving the educational infrastructure

Financial allocation: 53,1 mil Euro

- Construction/rehabilitaton and new equipments for kindergartens
- Construction/rehabilitaton and equipments investments for elementary schools
- Construction/rehabilitaton and equipments investments profesional and technical schools
- Construction/rehabilitaton and equipments investments for public universities

Potential beneficiaries: Administrative units (authorities and public administrations), institutions of higher education
