


Bucharest-Ilfov Region

The efforts and innovations that cities are undertaking to tackle these challenges can and should be strengthened and facilitated by the wide range of EUlevel strategies, programmes and initiatives in these fields.

Regional Opeartional Program (ROP) 2007-2013

The integrated urban development and regeneration plans contributed to the achievement of specific objective of ROP, namely increasing the economic and social role of urban centers, in order to have a more balanced development of regions.

The integrated urban development plans were implemented by projects addressing the following issues:

- Rehabilitation of the urban infrastructure and improvement of urban services, including urban transport
- Development of sustainable business environment
- □ Rehabilitation of social infrastructure, including social housing and improvement of social services

 Urban regeneration as a goal of the urban society could include: rehabilitation, modernization, renewal of the urban constructions, purifying the environment of the residential areas, a sustainable development of all these components, in view of satisfying the comfort demands of the population

 Economical strategy of a sustainable development imposes certainly to promote efficiency and a rational energy use in buildings as the major energy consumer in Romania and the other member states of the European Union (EU).




