CALL 2

Call launched on: July 27, 2016:

Period for submitting projects: August 28, 2017 - February 28, 2018

Value allocated for the Bucharest-Ilfov region: 70.04 million Euro



Investment Priority 3.1 A: Supporting the Energy Efficiency of Residential Buildings

Types of eligible works

- thermal rehabilitation of the envelope
- thermal rehabilitation of the heating system / hot water supply system
- installing alternative systems for producing renewable energy
- other activities that lead to energy efficiency

Potential beneficiaries: Territorial and Administrative Divisions (UAT)

Project's total eligible value:

Minimum eligible value: EUR 100,000 Maximum eligible value: EUR 5 million



Investment Priority 3.1 B: Supporting the Energy Efficiency of Public Buildings

CALL 1

Call launched on: December 28, 2016:

Period for submitting projects: February 28, 2017 - October 4, 2017

Value allocated for the Bucharest-Ilfov region: EUR 35.74 million



Investment Priority 3.1 B Types of eligible works

- thermal rehabilitation of the building's envelope
- thermal rehabilitation of the heating system / hot water supply system
- installing alternative systems for producing electricity and/or thermal energy for own consumption
- installing / rehabilitating / modernizing the air conditioning system, natural and mechanical ventilation in order to ensure the indoor air quality
- rehabilitation / modernization of the buildings lighting installation
- integrated energy management for buildings and other activities that lead to meeting the project's objectives

Potential beneficiaries: central public authorities, local public authorities, prefect's institution, partnerships between the entities listed above

Investment Priority 3.1.B

Applicant's financial contribution

- » local public authorities and institutions at least 2% of the total eligible expenditures
- » central public authorities at least 20% of the total eligible expenditures
- Plus all the non-eligible expenditures

Project's total eligible value:

Minimum eligible value: EUR 100,000 Maximum eligible value: EUR 25 million Using the exchange rate of 4.5172 RON/EUR



Investment Priority 3.1.C: Improving the Energy Efficiency in the Public Lighting Sector

The guideline was under public consultation during the May 2-16, 2017 period

Type of activities

- replacing the filament public lighting systems with lamps having high energy efficiency;
- acquiring/installing telemanagement systems for public lighting;
- expanding the public lighting system to urban localities



Investment Priority 3.1.C

Eligible applicants:

- » Administrative and Territorial Division (UAT) from the urban areas
- » UAT of the Municipality of Bucharest

Project's total eligible value:

- » Minimum eligible value: EUR 100,000
- » Maximum eligible value: EUR 1,500,000



Specific objective 3.2: Reducing the carbon emissions in the urban area based on sustainable urban mobility plans

Call launched on: July 20, 2017

Period for submitting projects : September 20, 2017 -March 20, 2018

Value allocated for the Bucharest-Ilfov Region: EUR 136.64 million



Specific objective 3.2:

Types of activities:

- •A. Investments designed to improve the urban public transportation
- •B. Investments designed for electric and non-motorized transportation
- •C. Other investments designed for reducing the CO2 emissions in the urban areas
- Eligible applicants: Partnerships between the administrative and territorial divisions of the eligible cities/municipalities and the administrative and territorial divisions of communes and which fulfill the condition on territorial vicinity and/or the districts of the Municipality of Bucharest
- In what concerns the Bucharest-Ilfov region, the Partnership Leader will be represented by the Municipality of Bucharest



Specific objective 3.2:

- Minimum eligible value: EUR 500,000
- Maximum eligible value:
- » EUR 5 million for the cities/municipalities with a population of less than 20,000 inhabitants;
- » EUR 10 million for the cities/municipalities with a population of more than 20,000 inhabitants;
- » EUR 40 million for the Municipality of Bucharest (as an exception)

Investment Priority 5.1: Preservation, Protection, Promotion and Development of the Natural and Cultural Heritage

CALL 2

Call launched on: July 12, 2017

Period for submitting projects: July 27, 2017 -November 27, 2017

Value allocated for the Bucharest-Ilfov region: EUR 20.24 million

Investment Priority 5.1: Types of activities:

- restoration, consolidation, protection and preservation of the historical monuments;
- restoration, protection, preservation and production of indoor paintings, frescoes, outdoor murals;
- restoration and remodeling of the facades' plastic art elements;
- interior endowments (installations, equipment and endowments necessary in order to meet the air-conditioning, fire safety and anti-theft conditions);
- endowments to expose and protect the mobile and immobile cultural heritage;
- marketing and touristic promotion activities for the restored objective, including its digitalization within the project.

Potential beneficiaries: local and central public authorities, worship units, NGOs and partnerships between these entities

Minimum value: EUR 100,000 Maximum value: EUR 5 mil. /10 mil. UNESCO



Investment Priority 5.2: Implementing actions intended to improve the urban environment, revitalize cities, regenerate and decontaminate the brownfileds (including the reconversion areas), reducing air pollution and promoting the noise reduction measures CALL 2

Call launched on: March 14, 2017:

Period for for submitting projects: April 15, 2017 -October 15, 2017

Value allocated for the Bucharest-Ilfov region: EUR 13.89 million

Investment Priority 5.2: Types of activities

- increasing the surface of green areas
- functional reconversion and/or reutilization of certain lands and degradated or unutilized surfaces inside the cities, and transforming them in leisure and free time areas for the community
- demolishing the buildings located on lands subject to interventions;
- developing pedestrian alleys, bicycle lanes, sidewalks;
- fitting out green areas
- creating recreational facilities for the developed lands (e.g., special sports areas, playgrounds for children, etc.);
- installing Wi-Fi in the public areas;
- endowment with urban furniture (benches, trash cans, etc.);
- modernizing the urban streets neighboring the lands subject to interventions, including replacing and/or connecting them to public



Investment Priority 5.2:

Potential beneficiaries: administrative and territorial divisions located in the urban area, Municipality of Bucharest, including its districts, partnerships between the UAT located in the urban area and the county UAT

Investment minimum value: EUR 100,000

Investment maximum value: EUR 5,000,000



INFRASTRUCTURE OF REGIONAL AND LOCAL IMPORTANCE

Investment Priority 6.1: Stimulating regional mobility by connecting the secondary and tertiary nodes to the TEN-T network, including the multimodal nodes

First call: May 25, 2016 - November 25, 2016 Second call: January 6, 2017 - July 6, 2017 Value allocated for the Bucharest-Ilfov region: 13 million EUR



Investment Priority 6.1:

Types of activities

- Modernization/rehabilitation of the county road infrastructure that ensures connectivity with the TEN-T network;
- Construction / modernization of the ring roads having the status of county road
- Construction / modernization of the bypasses having the status of county road, roundabouts
- Construction / modernization / rehabilitation of passages / road notes (construction only in order to ensure direct connectivity of the county roads to TEN-T highways) and construction of pedestrian catwalks



PRIORITY AXIS 9: SUPPORTING THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL REGENERATION OF THE DISADVANTAGED COMMUNITIES LOCATED IN URBAN AREAS Investment Priority 9.1 Types of activities

infrastructure

- investments in the habitation construction/rehabilitation/modernization of social houses
- investments in the health infrastructure, social services
- investments in the education infrastructure
- Investments intended for developing the degraded urban areas, respectively: construction/rehabilitation/modernization the buildings in order to host different social, community, cultural, leisure and sports, etc
- Creation/rehabilitation/modernization of the urban public areas

Potential beneficiaries

Partnerships (local action group) between representatives of the local public authorities, institutions, local business environment, civil society, marginalized urban area selected for the intervention
