Day 2 - 11th July 2018

09.30 - 11.30: Action Plan Development - Feasibility Check and Challenge Workshop

Based on a template for discussion (see attached), partners split into couples to exchange on their Action Plans to gather feedback from other partners on Point 1: an overview of their actions and the link the NMP-REG and Point 2: any challenges they face / concerns. The workshop will be organised as follows:

0930 - 0945: Introduction and input presentation, Jessica Huntingford, Resolvo Srl

0945 – 1115: Division into couples for 30 minute sessions.

In each session region 1 presents one of their Actions and region 2 comments (15 minutes) and the roles are then reversed (15 minutes). Partners can choose which action(s) to present in each group (changing action if their plan includes more than one, or repeating for different points of view if they are focusing on just one action). As there are 5 regions, in each group 1 region is "floating". This means that they can choose to participate as an observer in one of the other sessions.
