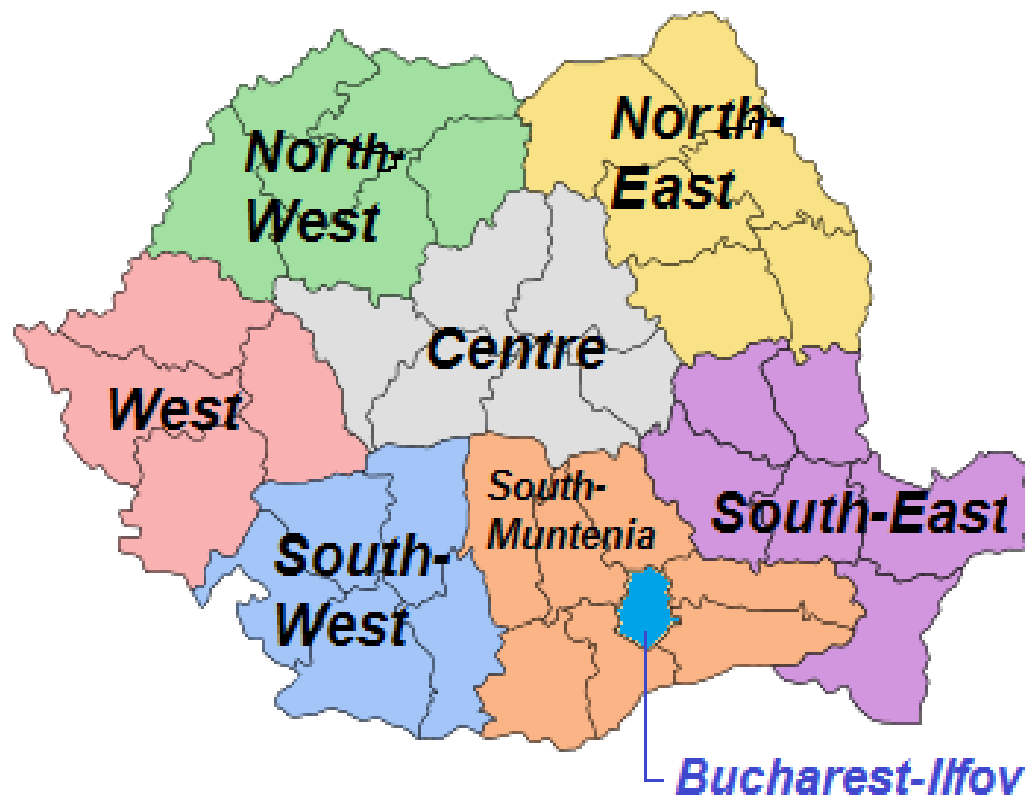

ROMANIA - 8 regions for socio-economic development
Law nr.315 / 2004

Following the principles of EU regional development and cohesion policy

CDRBI - decisional body

BIRDA - executive body

BIRDA – Bucharest-Ilfov Regional Development Agency

- Non-governmental, public utility, non-profit body
- 1999 - NGO for public utility
- 2004 - up date regional development law
- 2007 - intermediate body for REGIO

Agency for Regional Development Bucharest-Ilfov ARD BI

12-year Intermediate Body for the Regional Operational Program (ROP), with the task of informing and promoting, selecting, contracting, monitoring and verifying projects

Regional Planning and Programming - the development of the Bucharest Ilfov Regional Development Plan was started for the period of 2021-2027

Promotes the region and carries out activities stemming from regional development policies

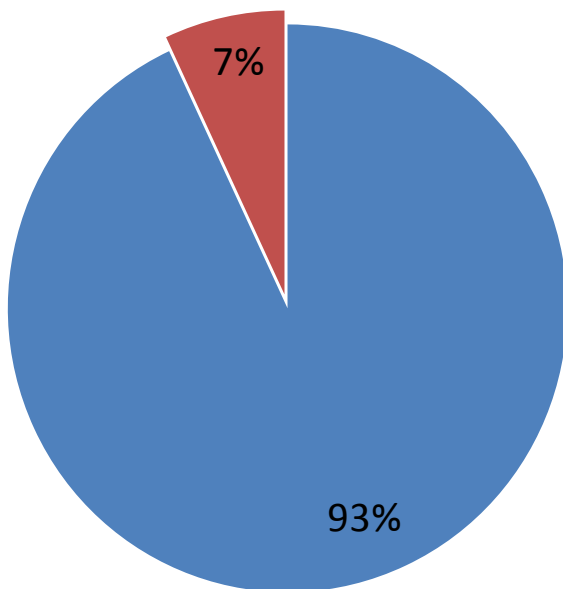

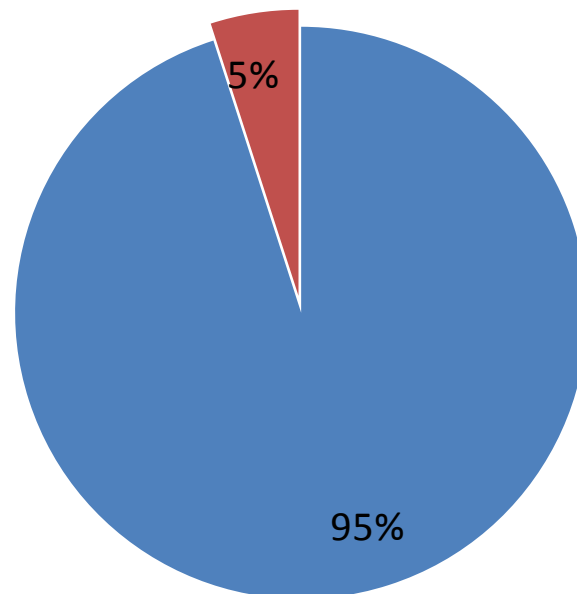
Allocation of RBI 2007-2013

Investment Priority 3.1 A:

Energy efficiency of housing buildings

Eligible activities:

- a. thermal rehabilitation of the envelope
- b. thermal rehabilitation of the heating system/warm consumption water supply system
- c. the installation of alternative systems of energy generation from renewable sources
- d. other activities that lead to energy efficiency

Assigned value for BI region: 99.4 million Euro

REGIO 2007-2013 Results

Energy efficiency of residential buildings :

- Number of blocks thermally rehabilitated to increase energy efficiency – 261
- Total energy savings by rehabilitated apartments – 155,333.019 GWH/year

Investment Priority 3.1 B:

Energy efficiency of public buildings

Eligible activities:

- a. thermal rehabilitation of the building envelope
- b. thermal rehabilitation of the heating system/warm consumption water system
- c. installing alternative electrical and/or thermal power systems for personal consumption
- d. installation/rehabilitation/upgrading of air-conditioning, natural ventilation and mechanical ventilation systems to ensure indoor air quality

Assigned value for BI region: 45.5 million Euro

Investment Priority 3.1 C:

Improving energy efficiency in public lighting

Eligible activities:

- a. replacing public lighting systems based on filament lamps with high energy efficiency lamps
- b. procurement/installation of public lighting tele-management systems
- c. expanding the public lighting system in urban areas

Assigned value for BI region: 5 million Euro

Investment Priority 3.2:

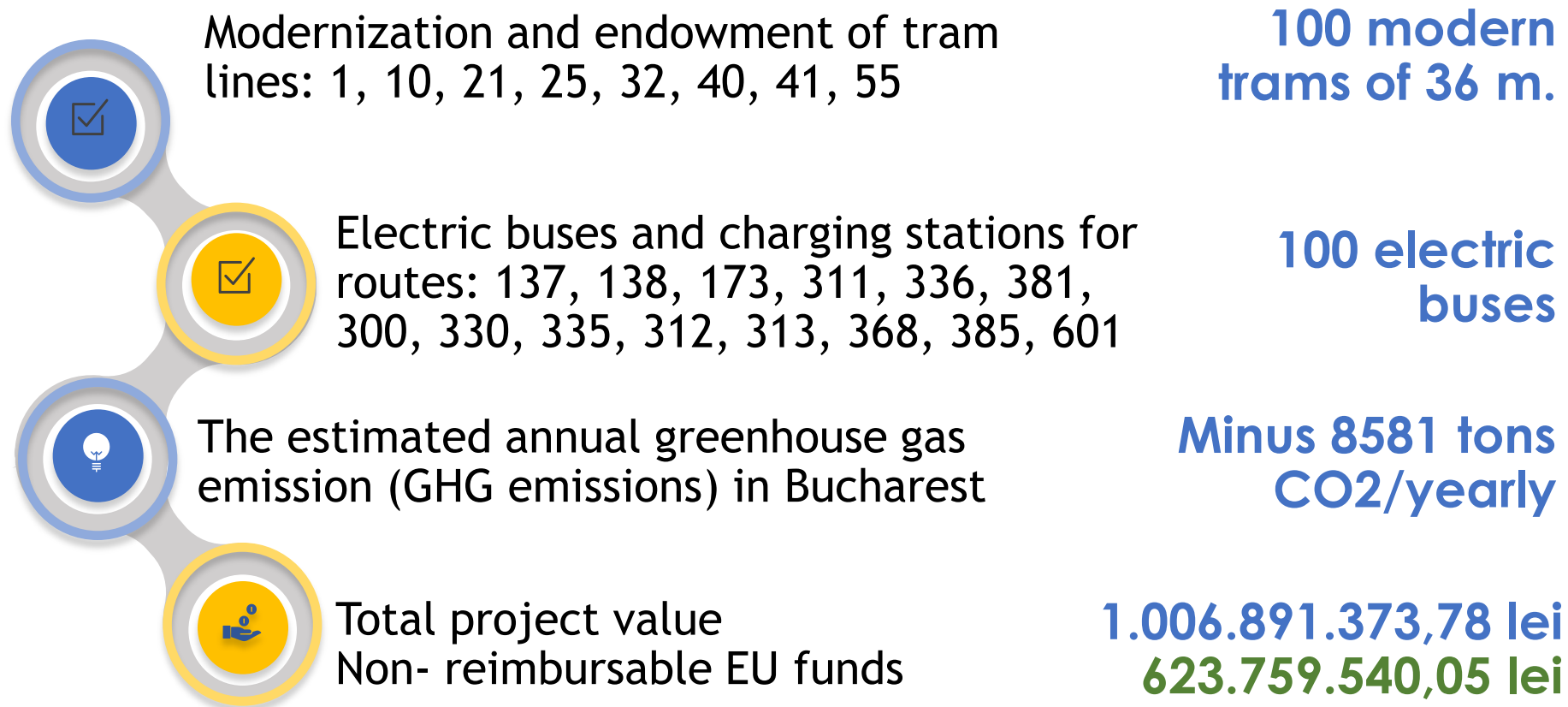
Sustainable urban mobility

Eligible activities:

- a. Investments to improve urban public transport**
- b. Investments for electric and non-motorized transport**
- c. Other investments to reduce CO2 emissions in the urban area**

Assigned value for BI region: 149.9 million Euros

Investment Priority 5.2:

Actions for urban regeneration

Eligible activities:

- a. expanding green areas
- b. functional reconversion and/or reuse of degraded or unused land and areas within cities and their transformation into recreational and leisure areas
- c. the demolition of buildings located on land subject to interventions
- d. building pedestrian alleys, bicycle tracks

Assigned value for BI region: 14.1 million Euro
