ADRBI provides specific services to the local public administration as well as to the private sector for the development of the Bucharest-Ilfov Region


Regional administration






Regional administration II

- Bucharest Capital City, with 6 districts
- 8 towns
- 32 communes
- 91 villages



General context - Bucharest-Ilfov Region

Structure of the population

- Bucharest 100% urban population (2.15 mil. inh.)
- Ilfov 54% rural population (245,292 inh.)
- Bucharest-Ilfov population at risk of poverty or social exclusion rate, by macroregions and development region – 21.4%

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Public transport

- Surface transport STB under Bucharest Municipality General Council
 - Covers all the Capital Cities and some areas of Ilfov county

- Subway transport Metrorex under Ministry of Transport
 - The most efficient 51 metro stations, only in the Capital City

Sustainable Urban Mobility Plan for Bucharest-Ilfov 2016-2030 (SUMP) (I)

An instrument of development policy, complementary to the General Urban Plan (GUP)

All the local authorities from Bucharest and Ilfov Council (48)

The main goal: Achieving an efficient, integrated, sustainable and safe transport system that promotes economic, social and territorial development and ensures a good quality of life

>7 bill. euros investments









Sustainable Urban Mobility Plan for Bucharest-Ilfov 2016-2030 (SUMP) (II)

SUMP, **mandatory** for the implementation of the projects through the Regional Operational Program (REGIO) and the Operational Program for Infrastructure (POIM) - 2014-2020

Strategic objectives:

- **1. Accessibility** for people from A to B;
- Improving safety and security while traveling;
- **3. Environmental protection** reducing pollution, greenhouse gas emissions and energy consumption promotion of non-motorized transport and public electric transport;
- 4. Economic efficiency
- 5. Urban quality

Sustainable Urban Mobility Plan for Bucharest-Ilfov 2016-2030 (SUMP) (III)


Investment projects

- Extension and modernization of the metro network
- Rehabilitation and extension of the tram network
- Park & Ride
- Parking policy
- Pedestrian areas

Institutional framework

- Set-up the Transport Authority at regional level
- Reorganisation of RATB from autonomous administration into a commercial company -STB.
- Integrated ticketing system; integrated transport management system.
- Set up a training center
- Training programmes for traffic safety and security

Transport poverty



Yes, quite good

Cheap price

- Good quality on metro trains
- Mix quality on buses, trams
- Bad quality trolleybuses
- Not a proper place for making friends
- Not so friendly for people with disabilities

Strengths and weaknesses

- Steps to an integrated system
- Prices of a ticket:
 - 0.27 euro/journey for surface transport
 - 0.52 euro/journey for subway
 - 0.72 euro/journey for bus express line (eg., Airport-Centre,
 ~20 km) vs. Romania
- Free transport for retired persons (surface) and students in Bucharest + other categories
- Money losses because of people traveling fraudulently (especially on surface)
- April 2020 the first time partnership Metrorex local authority (District 4)

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2017 study: Bucharest-Ilfov, the region with the worst transport services in Romania – based on citizens' self-perception





New acquisitions

- 400 Diesel busses Euro 6 in 2019
- 100 tramways and 100 electric busses expected starting with 2020 – projects on Regional Operational Programme / ERDF
- 130 hybrid busses Mercedes-Benz contract signed in March 2020
