

- 2021-2027 - managing authority for REGIO

- **An instrument for regional development green arena and reduction in carbon emissions**


REGIO Investment priorities:

- **Supporting the energy efficiency of residential buildings (>1000 blocks of apartments)**
- **Supporting the energy efficiency of public buildings, including cultural monuments, kindergartens, schools, universities (76 projects)**
- **Improving the energy efficiency in the public lighting sector (3 cities)**
- **Promoting the sustainable multimodal mobility (new trams, electric buses, modernized infrastructure in Bucharest, Chitila, Mogoșoaia, Voluntari cities)**



Urban Regeneration with REGIO

- increasing the areas of green spaces
- functional reconversion and / or reuse of degraded or unused land and areas within cities and their transformation into recreational and leisure areas for the community.
