

Implementing the Regional Operational Program (ROP) 2014-2020

- Total allocation: EUR 419,4 mil.
- 226 contracted projects
- Expected results:
 - > 55.400 households with a better classification of energy consumption
 - ➤ 513 equivalent tones of CO₂ estimated annual decrease of greenhouse gases
 - > 10 historical monuments restored/being restored
 - > 96.000 additional visitors to the heritage sites
 - > 4 green spaces created in urban areas, in Ilfov towns
 - > 8700 students who will benefit from better conditions in schools
 - > 100 new modernized trams

Objective:

The functional reconversion and reuse of a degraded land, with a total area of 60,923 sqm, by transforming it into a modern park properly equipped with sports and recreation facilities suitable for all the ages.


Impact of the project on the community:

- ➤ Green areas for promenade and rest, relaxation and party areas of free time with friends and/or family (91.5% of the park area)
- Multipurpose sports fields, tennis courts, places for fitness activities
- Children's playgrounds, bike and roller paths
- > Summer theatre/cinema, gazebos with barbecues
- Increasing the community's responsibility to preserve its land

Objective: to preserve, protect and exploit the cultural heritage and cultural identity of the Bucharest-Ilfov region in order to stimulate local and regional development.

Impact of the project on the community:

- Can be visited in the centre of Bucharest
- ➤ Restoration of an emblematic heritage objective (1,750 square meters of paintings, 1,638 square meters of green spaces and 1,006 square meters of sidewalks, pedestrian alleys, bathrooms, technical rooms and an ornamental lighting system were set up)
- A minimum 10% increase in the average annual number of visitors.
- Digitization of the historical monument, a new website in RO, EN, FR https://domnitabalasa.ro/
- > A spiritual and recreational space for the inhabitants of the area


